

Berks County 4-H 14th Annual Model Horse Show

Show Starts at 9:00AM

Check-in begins at 8:00AM and all exhibitors must check in upon arrival. No exhibitors are allowed in the show hall prior to 8AM.

Entry Fees:

If Paid By March 27th, 2010

Open - \$45

Novice - \$20

Entries arriving with a postmark after March 27th, 2010 will be charged a \$10 late fee.

*Entries may **NOT** be made by e-mail and we cannot accept Paypal for entry fees. Late fees **will not** be waived for any reason. Calling or e-mailing does **NOT** guarantee you table space.*

Members of 4-H will receive a 50% discount on their entry fees.

All entries entitle the shower to 1/2 of an 8ft table. Showers may purchase an additional 1/2 of a table for \$10.

Registration:

Registration is limited to the space we have available and will be given on a first-come, first-serve basis. You may enter day of show but we do reserve the right to refuse entry once the tables we have available have filled up.

If you are entering after March 27th it is recommended that you call or e-mail ahead to see if there will be space available for day of show entries. However, calling to say you will be coming on the day of the show does *NOT* reserve you a table. These will still be handed out on a first-come, first-serve basis on show day (if there are any left at that point). We have a limited number of tables and once they are full we *will* refuse further entries. This particularly applies to day of show entries as we don't want to see you drive to the show hall only to be turned away.

If you are unable to attend and would like someone to Proxy your horses, you may pay \$5 per horse per class or pay \$45 for a half or \$55 for a whole table. Fill out the entry form and add the name of the person showing for you and the word Proxy by their name. You must also include a list of the horses being shown for you.

All Entrants **must** check-in upon arrival. Unloading will be allowed through the main front doors and second, third, and fourth sets of side doors. Once you have unloaded you **MUST** move your vehicle immediately.

Awards:

1. Flat ribbons for First through Eighth place in all classes.
2. Rosettes for Champions and Reserves
3. Trophies or Plaques for Grand and Reserve Grand Champions

Rules:

PLEASE READ ALL RULES CAREFULLY!

1. You are responsible for the behavior of any children in your care.
2. Due to space restrictions on the show tables, halter horses may not be shown standing on pieces of felt or bases **unless** the base is required for the horse to stand (IE Huck Bey and Smarty Jones models) or the horse is fragile (IE chinas) and needs to be laid down. If your horse is shown lying down, please be on hand to turn them over for the judge or risk disqualification.
3. Tags will not be provided. Please supply your own. These should have the horse's name and owner's name on one side and the horse's breed and gender on the other side; foals should also have an age on their tags along with their breed & gender. When the horse is placed on the table the breed & gender side must be facing up or the horse will be disqualified from the class. If tags have additional information on them (i.e. numbers from one of the regional numbering systems) that is fine.

Tables:

Tables will be pre-assigned. Please see our policy on seating requests below.

Table coverings are not provided, please bring your own.

Seating Requests:

Requests to sit next to specific people may be made, however I cannot guarantee that they will be honored. Requests for specific tables in the hall may **not** be made unless there is a special need (such as a handicap) which must be met.

Class Restrictions:

2 horses per performance class and 3 horses per halter class.

Halter horses may show in only ONE class and Performance horses may show in only ONE seat.

Division Definitions:

Novice: For showers who have won fewer than two Grand Championships. Showers are limited to *OF horses only*. No CMs may be shown in this division. Novices may not enter any other division. They are to show their own horses. This means that those horses may not be shown in the Open division as well. Novices are to place and set up their own horses & displays.

OF: Factory produced horses in any material.

Custom: Horses of any material who have been modified from their factory OF condition show in here.

Artist Resin: For all artist resin horses or original sculptures.

OF Mini: Horses in the Stablemate/Chips or Paddock Pal/Little Bit/Pebbles Scales OR similar. OF Minis may be shown **ONLY** in this division. CM/AR Minis will show in the regular CM and AR Divisions.

OF China: All factory finish china horses. These horses may show **ONLY** in this division. Custom glaze or cold-painted chinas must show in the CM division.

Championships:

For Performance - Championships will be decided by callbacks of all first and second place horses. Please bring any additional performance ribbons that those horses have won as well since the Championships will be decided based on what ribbons were won.

For Halter - Championships will be decided by callbacks of all first place horses. We will **NOT** be bringing back second place horses for these championships.

Grand Championships will be decided by callbacks of all champion and reserve champion horses. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to keep these horses on hand for their callbacks.

Time Limits:

There will be a strict time limit between classes of 5 minutes for Performance and 3 minutes for halter. This will be in place in ALL divisions. Please have your horses ready to show ***BEFORE*** bringing them up to the rings. Once a class is closed all showers must clear away from the entry ring.

Directions to the Berks County 4-H Center

Do not use Map Quest to obtain directions; they will be inaccurate!

From Pottstown: Travel Route 422 West (not Business Route 422) and stay on that bypass around Reading (stay in left hand lane) which becomes Route 222 North. Travel on this route directly to the Route 183 exit. Follow directions from Route 183 below.

From Lebanon: Travel Route 422 East through Sinking Spring and turn left up the hill onto Mull Avenue (big intersection with Route 724 at McDonald's. Travel through 3 traffic lights to intersection with Route 222. Take Route 222 North (right turn) directly to the next exit, which is Route 183. Follow directions from Route 183 below.

From Lancaster: Travel Route 222 North (not Business Route 222) toward Reading and Allentown (do not take Route 222 Business) and stay on that bypass around Reading, avoiding Shillington. Travel on this 2 lane expressway directly to the Route 183 exit. Follow directions from Route 183 below.

From Route 183: Take Route 183 North to the traffic light at West Leesport Road.

Turn left and follow West Leesport Road through the housing development.

Turn right onto County Road.

The Berks County 4-H Community Center will be on the left – look for the 4-H Clover sign.

There is a lot of new construction in the area. If you feel lost, stop and ask for directions before you go too far. The 4-H Center is on the county lands on the same road as the Berks Heim and the Berks County Prison (most Berks Countians will know where those 2 landmarks are).
